

## A Guide to using your World Book Online subscription with Google Drive and Google Classroom

It's now easier to **save, store, and share** World Book Online content through your personal Google account with **Google Drive** and **Google Classroom**. Some of the benefits of this seamless integration include:


● **Making lesson planning easier.** Save article content for various units of study and make it accessible to students for an assignment or other teachers who may also have similar needs. This can be done by opening saved articles from your Drive file with Google Docs or saving files to a class for an assignment in Google Classroom.

● **Create assessments** based on article content and allow students to respond in real-time from home or from the classroom. Students can work collaboratively from anywhere in the world, and teachers can provide ongoing and simultaneous feedback.

● **Simplify communications with parents!** Easily share collections of articles read, or assignments completed using World Book Online content with Google Drive so parents are well versed and no longer need to ask "What did you learn in school today?"


### Follow these steps to start saving content to your Google account!




2 Choose an Account to link with World Book Online


To Share World Book Online content to Google classroom, choose the "Share" menu from the Tools and Settings menu of an image or article and select "Google Classroom."
